- Responsible for development and management of the department expense budget and development and tracking of Site Services Capital budget.
- Works directly with all levels across the organization and with VP level Leadership in Engineering, Finance, & R & D.
- Manage a department with six direct reports and responsibility for Space Planning, Move Management and associated Technology.
- Manage the Facilities Management technology and database (Archibus, CAFM, etc.) for analysis and financial reporting.
